This week, the Ad Hoc Committee continued our work of developing a proposal for the future of the CPUC building and property. We met with Relèven (<https://releven.org>), a charitable organization that helps congregations “lovingly preserve, restore and repurpose underutilized churches into community hubs and affordable housing.” We also organized a meeting between the South Osborne Childcare Coalition, local politicians and Cooperatives First to discuss various models (and sources of funding) for childcare centres. We are sifting through information from these meetings and hope to have a recommendation for the Leadership Team and the congregation by the end of August.
