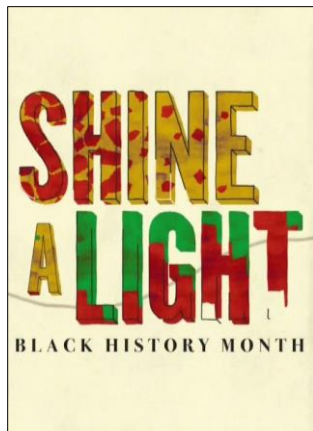

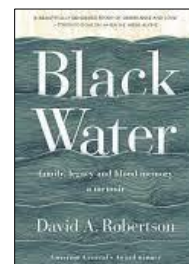

Below are the amounts CPUC has received as credits on our bi-monthly billings. They total up to \$1,124.47 for 2022. The 62 panels produced a total of 21,827 KWH of electricity which accounted for 79% of all the electricity used by CPUC in 2022.
