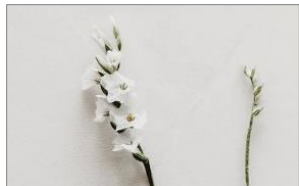

#### **Passion, Exploration and Innovation: The United Church Past and Present**

After worship, on Sunday, Nov 3., please stay for our first presentation/discussion to mark the 2024 Stewardship Campaign. We are delighted to welcome Rev. Peter Douglas who will lead a presentation and discussion about his father, the Rev. Fred Douglas.

About our Speaker: Peter Douglas served in five congregations within the city, plus a couple of rural parishes. Though God may be the same “yesterday, today and forever”, Peter observes, the Church is not.

About our Topic: “Wave to everyone you see ... even the people you don't see ... because they may see you”, advises Fred Douglas. This is the story of Fred Douglas. Fred saw the building of 13 new churches in Winnipeg, initiated the creation of housing for seniors and raised millions of dollars for the Church. But, most importantly, Fred waved to people and made them visible.
