Dawn Rolke Sabbatical: June 15 – October 12, 2025

In the United Church, ministers become eligible for a paid sabbatical of 12 weeks after serving in one pastoral charge for five years. This time is in addition to the minister's annual 5 weeks of vacation time and 3 weeks of study leave.

Dawn is taking a sabbatical in 2025. The Future Directions Team was asked to create a plan for the congregation for Dawn's time away. Team members considered how the congregation could use the time to do our own sabbatical: to engage our journey as a faith community in transition, a community less defined by our building and property and more aligned with other aspects of mission and vision. Here are the beginning ideas of that plan.

“Home and Away”

April 1, June 1 – Congregational Potlucks to discuss and prepare for Sabbatical.

June 15 – Worship off site, but in South Osborne. A displaced church, strangers in a familiar land, still rooted in the larger community.

June 22 – Worship at Churchill Park. Reflection on the experience of being somewhere else and preparation for the upcoming months. ***Journey Journals*** with guiding questions will be distributed to help people keep track of their journey.
