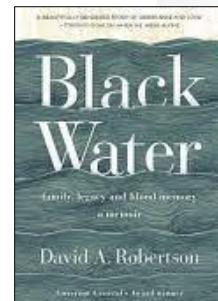


Steve Heinrichs, a lifelong Mennonite and passionate Winnipegger, is a writer, speaker and community organizer.
